FURTHER RESOLVED, that the president, the chief executive officer, the chief operating officer, the treasurer or the manager of the Company (collectively, the "Designated Officers") shall be, and each of them, acting alone, hereby is, authorized, directed and empowered on behalf of and in the name of the Company to: (a) verify and execute, the Petition, verify and execute any ancillary documents thereto to be filed with the Bankruptcy Court and make or cause to be made prior to execution thereof any modifications as any such Designated Officer, in such officer's discretion, deems necessary or desirable to carry out the intent and accomplish the purposes of these resolutions (such approval to be conclusively established by the execution thereof by such Designated Officer); (b) execute, verify and file or cause to be filed all responses, schedules, lists, motions, applications and other papers or documents (including debtor-in-possession loan documents) necessary or desirable in connection with the foregoing; and/or (c) execute and verify any and all other documents necessary or appropriate in connection therewith in such form or forms as any such Designated Officer may approve;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Designated Officers of the Company shall be, and each of them, acting alone, hereby is, authorized, directed and empowered to retain, on behalf of the Company: (a) Tavenner & Beran, PLC; and (b) such additional professionals including, without limitation, other attorneys, accountants, financial advisors, investment bankers, consultants or brokers, in each case as in such officer's or officers' judgment may be necessary in connection with the Petition, the Company's Chapter 11 case and other related matters, on such terms as any Designated Officers shall approve;


